The prompt for this is local government reform. From 1 April 2015, the 26 council model of local government will be replaced by a model of 11 councils. However, the Education and Libraries (NI) Order 1986, provides for the territorial responsibilities and governance arrangements of the five current Education and Library Boards (ELBs) in terms derived from the 26-council model. Legislative change is required, therefore, to ensure education administration is compatible with local government reform. Primary legislation to establish a single body, the Education Authority, is considered to be the most efficient and effective way of providing administrative arrangements for education which are compatible with new local government structures.
