In regard to the after-treatment, generally speaking, the bandage is retained for twenty-four hours; afterward, the bichloride solution (1 to 500) is rubbed on to the conjunctival surface every day for six to ten days. This treatment should be supplemented by bathing the eyes with a solution of boric acid two or three times daily. Applications of the nitrate of silver are usually required if the redness of the conjunctiva continues for more than ten days or two weeks. In cases where there is subsequent keatitis, insufflations of calomel powder are of advantage. As a matter of fact, each case must receive after-treatment on its own merits. It is better to have the patient in the hospital for two to four days after the operation; however, they do very well when treated as out patients....
