The Comptroller Gen-eral is to report to Congress any recommendations regarding Fed-eral legislation, regulations, or programs to improve elder justice in the United States. This section authorizes 6, 000, 000 for each fis-cal year 2009 through 2015. Sec. 3. Victim Advocacy Grants. Section 3 authorizes the Attor-ney General to award grants to study the special needs of victims of elder abuse, neglect, and exploitation. Funded activities include pilot programs for training and for the examination of...
